I am no plumber, but I have been told the water pressure at the new gardens is high. No I do not own a gauge, but someone might for investigation. So be aware, and consider turning your water on partway, before you turn on your water timers and irrigation lines.

The compost bin was just constructed this past Friday. The black perimeter construction silt fence should be removed shortly. Andy Jorgenson will be coming to review plots that had severe warped wood.

Please open both the left and right side of the gate when entering via a golf cart. It can be a tight fit with only one side open. So please open both sides, to decrease the chance of the gates getting damaged.

The issue of cars has been brought up. Yes cars and trucks are permissible thru the 10ft gates. We would prefer only for loading and unloading. And if you are blocking an aisle, or someone else's garden, please move your vehicle once done unloading. There is room for at least six vehicles before the gates. And the less traffic thru the gates, the less chance of the gates getting damaged.

There are 6 - 8ft aisles front to back. If someone is blocking an aisle, simply drive up a different aisle (or along the fence 10ft perimeter aisle), and come down the aisle from the opposite direction.
