Old Business:

The proposed changes to rule 11 of the Policies and Procedures were briefly discussed.

Proposed Additions to Rule 11.

- a. **All metal fence posts in and around the garden plot that measure 4 ft. or less must be capped with a protective device to protect people from injuries**
- b. **Plots that have fencing must have a gate or access point to enter as a matter of safety.**

A motion was made and seconded to approve the change. The Change passed.
